
What's Next?

Key Topics Covered

Process Mining

Process mining tools like Celonis aggregate and map organizational processes to identify inefficiencies and other process impacts which can be used to inform future Business Process Reengineering (BPR) and transformation efforts.



Robotic Process Automation

Robotic Process Automation (RPA) tools like UiPath introduce automation to the S/4HANA transformation journey through business process automation, process orchestration, and comprehensive testing.

Low Code Platforms

Low Code Platforms offer a customer-centric engagement layer to drive workflow automation in an intuitive experience, while maintaining a "clean core" in SAP. The "ERP+" architecture orchestrates cross-departmental functions and services, with an improved user experience and customer accessibility.

WalkMe

WalkMe provides an educational overlay to existing applications that supports change management efforts, reduces the need for training support, and increases user productivity.

GenAl

Accenture's GenWizard asset introduces GenAl into the S/4HANA transformation journey by reverse engineering legacy code to automatically generate user stories, requirements, functional documentation, and design documentation – among many other use cases.

Fireside Chat

The day concluded with a fireside chat between AFS and the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) where DLA shared how they are leveraging tools like Celonis, UiPath, and ServiceNow to increase automation and improve the user experience across SAP business processes.
